#### Sewer Costs in Shoestring to Be Heard

Shoestring addition residents in the vicinity of Redondo Beach boulevard will be given an opportunity to protest on March 2 against construction of sanitary sewers in their area.

The Los Angeles City Council set the hearing date in adopting an ordinance of intention for the improvement of the boulevard from Figueroa street to Vermont avenue, Residents of the area who benefit, from the improvement will pay all costs.

Grading of the playfield at El Camino College was under way this week, following award of a contract to Fred McKinley for his low bid, of \$11,480. The bid was considerably under the engineer's estimate of \$13,000 for the work.

The project involves the removal of the landmark familiarly known as "Mt. Winmer," containing an estimated 16,500 cubic yards of earth piled up several years ago to await the need of it. Some \$4100 cubic yards of sand and nearly '10,000 cubic yards of adobe will be excavated and spread in the grading operations.

Twelve other bids were received, ranging up to \$25,222.
Construction of, a frame and siding addition to the college office building also is under way this week at a cost of \$2650.




