# Minister of Torrance Christian Church Since 1945 to Join Chapman College The Rev. Ronald J. Menmuir, pastor of the First Christia Church of Torrance, is resigning his pastorate here March 1 t join the faculty at Chapman College in Los Angeles, where h will assume his new post March 15 as intsructor of religion. Rev. Menmuir, who took \* over the local Christian Church pastorate in October, 1945, sald he was leaving his post here with genuine regret. During his 3½ years here he chas more than doubled the congregation and the annual financial budget of the church, and added 187 new members to the church membership. Born in the gold fields of Western Australia, Mr. Menmuir came to Galifornia in 1930 to attend Chapman College to study for the Christian ministry. He received his Bachelor of Divinity degree from the Pacific School of Religion at Berkeley He now is working for his Ph.D. degree at University of Callfornia. He was pastor of Mills Tertrace Christian Church at Oct. March 15. 
