City, Santa Fe Named in \$190,000 Accident Suit

\$190,000 Accident Suit

A \$190,000 law suit being brought against the City of Torrance and the Santa Fe Railroad by a 23-year-old motorcyclist was due to go to the fury late yesterday or early this surroung. The case is being tried in the Superior Court in Long Beach.

The suit, charging the city and the railroad with negligence, was brought by Adrian C. Tatum who was injured in a trainmotorcycle accident at Dominguez street crossing on Creation Country, John Shidler, claims he suffered a basal skull fracture resulting in a paralysis of his right side.

Tatum claims there was no wig-wag nor "R. R." painted on the streets to warn of the crossing.
