In every community where strong employer organization has been achieved, labor diffi-cuities have dvindled to noth-ing, James M, Niccson, labor relations counselor retained by the Harbor Area Employers' Council, told the members of the Board of Directors of the Council April 20. Nicoson represented the Har-bor Area Employers' Council at the conference April 16, in Santa Barbara of all employers' coun-cills in the state.
