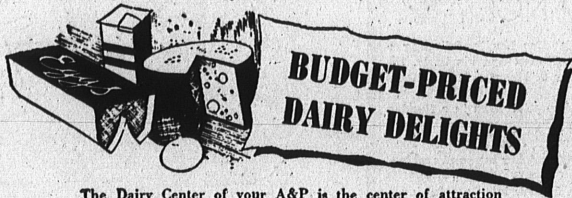
Seidel Quartet presentation will include numbers as follows: Quartet in E Flat by Mozart; Quartet Opus No. 12 by Mendelssohn.
