The same thing happens in your refrigerator. The cold inner walls condense moisture from the warm, moist air which rushes in every time you open the refrigerator.

Actually, moisture in the refrigerator is a desirable condition because high humidity is necessary for good food preservation. But excessive sweating is, of course, undesirable.

According to the Consumers Institute, there are three steps you can take to control internal sweating.
