When these men, elected by the confidence of the peo-ple, fail in that confidence, and fail to properly manage city affairs, and make illegal expenditures of the people's money, and when the members of the City Council place their own personal interests above the interests of the people, then the people are given, by law, a method of removing these undesirable councilmen from office. This method is known as a recall.
