Torrance Now 'Worth' More Than Last Year

Total assessed valuation of all real and personal property in the City of Torrance for 1949 is \$45,912,940, an increase of \$5,005,950 over 1948, it was reported this week to Supervisor Darby by County Auditor Joseph M. Lowery.
This includes secured property assessed at \$44,511,530 and unsecured person al property valued at \$2,402,410.

Darby disclosed officials of Torrance are required to submit the city tax rate to Lowery's office not later than Tuesday, August 30, at which time the Board of Supervisors will officially adopt the various county tax rates as well.

Total assessed valuation of all preceity in the county, including that located within the incorporated cities as well as that located in unincorporated territory amounts to \$5,204,316,370 a rise of \$861,078,675 over last year's figures, or an increase of 7,5 per cent.


