If renewal by mall is preferred, the private passenger car owner should mail his 1947 white registration card to the Department of Motor Vehicles in Sacramento, together with the correct 1948 fee, Personal checks or currency are not acceptable on mail applications.

To obtain the correct 1948 fee, look at the fee listed in the lower left corner of your 1947 registration certificate, add \$3.00 and round off the amount to the nearest dollar. The minimum fee is \$7.00.

With nearly \$250,000 worth of live Chinchillas entered, plans for the Fifth Annual Chinchilla Show have been completed by the California Chinchilla Ranchers Club. Several Torrance breeders will enter the affair.

The show will be held in the State Exposition building, Exposition Park, Los Angeles, Feb. 21-22 with entries from fur farms in more than a score of states competing for cups and other awards. The public will be admitted free.

Chinchilla growing is a transplanted California industry, having been started here 25 years ago when the late M. F. Chapman brought seven males and four females from Chile. He had hired 23 trappers to work 40 months, combing four nations for the little animals.

From that original breeding stock the Chinchilla breeding stock the Chinchilla business has grown into an industry of \$20,000,000 with 50,000 animals raised in practically every state of the Union and many in Canada.
