Four-fifths of that sum was expended in the following serious catastrophes: the Texas City explosion-fire; the Oklahoma-Texas Panhandle tornadoes; June floods in the midwest and several eastern states and the September hurricane that lashed 27 counties of Florida and 23 counties in Alabama, Mississippi and Louisiana.
