State Housing Act Made Ready For '48 Ballot

California voters will have a problem at the November elec-tions if an initiative petition filed with the Attorney General secures the necessary signatures to give it a place on the ballot.

The measure is sponsored by the California Housing Initiative Committee, of which Msgr Thomas J. O'Dwyer of Los An geles is chairman. It was placed before Howser by Harold F Wise, State Director of the com

The initiative proposes to the voters that the state constitution be amended to- create a State Housing Agency and equip it with authority and funds to assist local housing authorities and non-profit housing associa tions in the development and operation of low rent and mo-

derate rent dwellings.

The committee sponsoring the measure reported that it already had secured the endorsement of the executive committee of the California State Federation of Labor various posts of the Vot

Calfornia State Federation of Labor, various posts of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, the American Legion and the American Veterans' Committee, and civic and housing groups in many parts of the state.

It is expected that 100,000 homes will be built in four years if the proposal gets the slightly more than 204,000 signatures necessary to pul it on the November state ballot and meets voters approval.

No dwellings will be built by the State Housing Agency. All will be developed, owned and operated by local authorities or non-profit associations. The actual construction work will be done by private contractors after competitive bids.
