Scores of interesting docu ments and historical relics which played an important part in the early history of the United States, an exhibit closely related to the one carried on the Free dom Train, have been set up in the Los Angeles County Museum

4. Consolidation of small, unconomical governmental units be fostered.

Part-time students, on-the-job, and institutional-on-farm trainees and others will not be entitled to the increases, Colonel Cross said.

The new payments will be at the monthly rate of \$75 a month for a veteran without dependents, \$105 a month for a veteran with one dependent, and \$120 for a veteran with more than one dependent.

The higher rates are applicable to periods of training on and after April 1. However, since subsistence allowance checks are not due until the end of the month in which the veteran is in training, most of the eligible veteran-students will receive their first-checks at the higher rates on or shortly after May 1.
