Students Attend Religion Class At Grade Schools

Entering its seventh week of instruction, a total of 267 boys and girls of the fourth, fifth and sixth grades attending the Torrance Elementary, Fern Avenue and Walteria schools, were released for one hour of instruction to the four religious groups participating in the program.

groups participating in the program.

Religious groups participating in the program and their respective enrollments were as follows: Church Federation group, 97; Evangelical Released Time, 63; Catholic, 91 and Christian Science 16. Fifty-eight percent of the boys and girls, eligible for such instruction, were released from the Torrance Elementary School, where such instruction has been provided during the past two years. The average for the three schools is forty-eight percent, according to the Rev. H. Wesley Roloff, chairman of the Torrance Inter-Faith Committee. The Inter-Faith Committee acts as coordinating and clearing agency between the participating religious groups and the schools.

The Released Time program in religious instruction was made possible by a law adopted by the State Legislature in 1943.
