## There Is <br> No Dispute Over Clerk's Wages and Hours

Torrance Merchants Are Strictly Abiding by the Conditions of Their Previous Union Contract.

In order to correct a misunderstanding that seems to be quite prevalent, the MERCHANTS of Torrance wish to advise the public that THERE IS NO ARGUMENT NOR DISPUTE OVER WAGES AND HOURS BETWEEN LOCAL CLERKS AND RETAIL STORES NOW SERVING THIS AREA.

The wage scale under which Torrance clerks have been working for the past 18 months is as HIGH or HIGHER than is now being paid in any other city on the Pacific Coast. To the best of our knowledge, these wages are as high as specified in any Union Contract in the ENTIRE UNITED STATES.

The major difference between Torrance Merchants and Haskell Tidwell's Retail Clerks Union No. 905, is Tidwell's insistance that we sign a CLOSED SHOP CONTRACT, which is ILLEGAL under the Federal Labor-Management Relation Act. We also insist upon a fair and impartial arbitration clause for the settlement of future disputes.
