3-B | Health Expert CATHOLIC DAUGHTERS ARE HOSTESSES AT INFORMAL DINNER, EVENING ENTERTAINMENT Gives Advice On Sunstroke

With the advent of summer, the county health officer Dr. Roy O. Gilbert, M.D., offers a word of warning about sunstroke, in case you're working in a highly humid atmosphere. Exposure to direct rays of the sun should be avoided, Dr. Gilbert cautions. It is the infrared rays, not the violet rays of the sun should be avoided, Dr. Gilbert cautions. It is the infrared rays, not the violet rays of the sun, which cause sunstroke. Increased fluid intake, nonalcoholic, is also a preventive for either sunstroke or heat stroke. Tap water is better than ice water and the addition of salt tablets or small amounts of table salt is helpful.

An attack of sunstroke usually develops suddenly, starting with general depression, headache, dizziness, vomiting, thirst and convulsions. Services of a physician are needed because permanent injury to the brain and heart are possible.

First aid measures include Immediate removal of the patient to the shade, loosening of clothing and reduction of temperature through fanning and cold applications.


