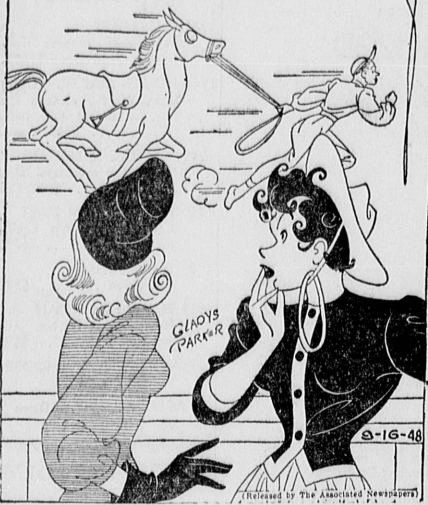

Building Hits \$101,000,000 During August

Building permit valuations for all Los Angeles County rocketed to a skyscraping all-time record of \$101,080,582 in August, lifting the eight-month 1948 total to \$622,592,590, a 52 per cent gain over the same period a year ago, the Los Angeles Chamber of Commerce reported today.

A \$38,700,000 life insurance company housing project in Los Angeles pushed the county-wide total to the new record, the chamber reported. The totals include Torrance and Lomita.

August residential permits totaled 4326, representing 7975 dwelling units—enough to accommodate more than 25,000 persons. County-wide residential construction hit \$74,784,019 in value.

Valuation of the 13,782 total permits was 44 per cent ahead of the \$69,930,065 of August, 1947, and 51 per cent over the \$64,584,398 of July.

Twenty-eight of 51 reporting offices showed increases over August, 1947, with 25 up over the previous month, Haake said.
