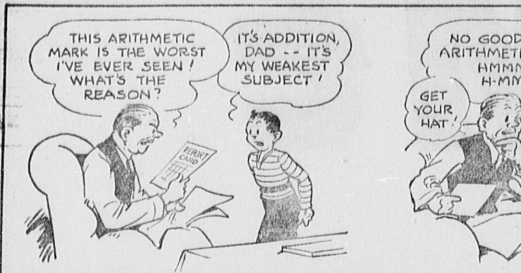

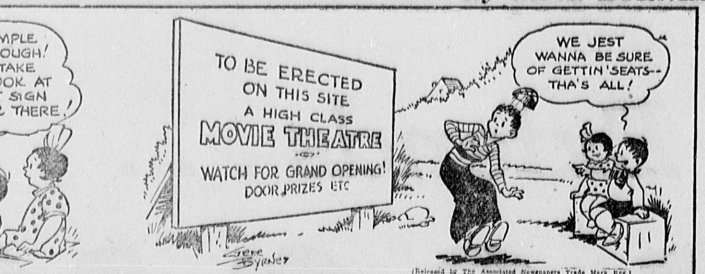

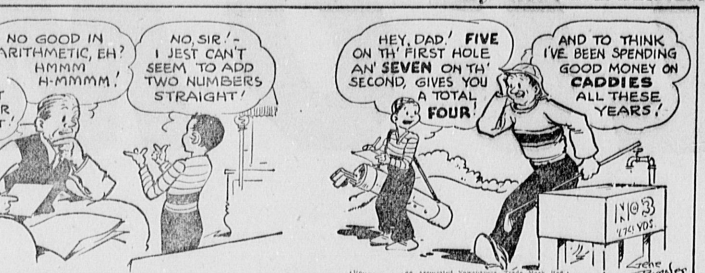
Get Benefit Shorten Time of TB Tests

Los Angeles county government employees who now enter military service will not be entitled to the customary six months to resume their positions after discharge from the armed forces. The Civil Service Commission has been so advised by Deputy Counsel Andrew Porter, who explained that under a new interpretation of the law, a public employee must apply for the job he left for military duty within 90 days. In addition, Porter said men being drafted under Selective Service will not be entitled to the 10 percent veterans preferential credit on civil service tests.

Living Costs Up in Month

Living costs in the Los Angeles metropolitan area, San Francisco, Seattle and Portland increased in August, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics report this week. The advances were due to price increases in three of the six major cost of living components—rent, house furnishings and miscellaneous items. Clothing dropped one half of one percent and fuel, electricity and ice, three tenths of one percent during the month, the report shows.
