## Tax-Deeded Lot Sale Begins at Hall of Justice

Here's a chance to own a lot in the county for as little as \$10—if you can get to the Hall of Justice in Los Angeles. Starting this week, almost 3400 lots are being sold at auction by the county tax collector for a minimum bid of \$10 each. The lots are tax-delinquent, and the best bid automatically wipes out back taxes. Prospective buyers are warned, however, that a tax title is not a clear title. Bonds and assessments must be satisfied, and title often must be cleared in court. Also a tax deed will not abolish existing easements.
