Varsity Whips Redondo, 14-7; Finishes Third in Bay League

Torrance's Varsity wound-up the '48 Bay League season Friday night after they went Seahawk hunting and came home with a full tilt.

The on-again-off-again, hot-and-cold Tartars were hot Friday night and gave the fans twice the admission price in thrills by downing Redondo Beach, 14-7 on the loser's gridiron.

The victory put Torrance in a three way tie for third place in the tough Bay League standings.

Torrance trailed for two quarters following Redondo's single score of the game which came in the first quarter. Jack Taylor attempted a quick kick for Torrance from his own 21-yard line. The boot was blocked and recovered by Redondo on the Tartar's 24-yard marker. Seahawk Dewey Falcone raced to the five on the next play and Bill Strickland went over on the following play. Falcone ran it to make it, 7-0.

Torrance hemmed and hawed around for the remainder of the half—seldom having the ball in their own territory.
