5-Point Corner Gets Another Overhaul Job

Still another plan of routing traffic through the five way "gunzel trap" at the intersection of Carson street, Cabrillo avenue, and Cravens avenue was put into operation by city crews this week.

Ultimate solution to the problem, according to City Manager George W. Stevens, was the installation of automatic traffic signals. Cost of the signals would be approximately \$7500. In the meantime, street crews were revamping the raised guide lanes to allow motorists casier access to Cravens avenue.

Revamping of the lanes followed a recent meeting of 15 Cravens avenue business and professional men and members of the city traffic commission. The business people said the shoppers had complained to them about the blocking of the Cravens avenue entrance.

Moving of the asphalt curbilities traffic guides, originally and purposely installed as a temporary measure, follows a plan of city officials to try out several suggested plans of traffic control in an attempt to find the most practical method, Permanent concrete curbs and raised islands eventually will be installed at the intersection, according to the city manager.
