

She can place three or four girls every week, and although she can sometimes use inexperienced girls who start at \$125 a month, most of the openings are for girls who can take dication at the rate of 100 to 120 words a minute. Beginning salaries for experienced girls range up to \$275 a month, with the average around \$200 with advancement promised in almost all jobs.

NEW CHRISTIAN SCHOOL PLANS UNDER STUDY
