**Newberry Store To Be Expanded**

Officials for the J. J. Newberry stores have announced plans to greatly enlarge the Torrance store at the corner of Sartori avenue and El Prado.

The store will be completely remodeled, new fixtures installed, and a new, modern front constructed, according to J. E. Howard, Pacific Coast director for the Newberry stores.

Howard estimated this week that the remodeling would cost approximately \$50,000 and that about \$75,000 in new fixtures would go into the enlarged store.

Also concerned with the enlarging are three other Torrance merchants.

Kale's Children Shop, 1277 Sartori avenue; Adams Dress Shop, 1279 Sartori avenue; and the Music Center, 1307 El Prado, are now occupying store space which will be taken over by Newberry's in their enlargement program.

Karl's Shoe store, which occupies the corner store in the large building, will not be moved.

No definite plans have been completed for moving the three shops which must vacate the building, but the proprietors of each are making arrangements to relocate in Torrance, they said yesterday.

Remodeling of the store will start immediately, J. H. Paget, manager of the store, said this week. The foundation for a warehouse to be built near the store has been laid.

When completed, the store will have 11,000 square feet of floor space or 3400 square feet more than at present.

The new and modern fixtures will permit an increase of 50 to 100 per cent in merchandise display area, according to Howard.

Expansion of the Newberry store in Torrance is further evidence of the city's rapidly growing shopping facilities. In addition to the Newberry expansion, 19 new business and commercial buildings are now in various stages of construction in the city.

**A Whale of a Lot of Wailing Local Hospital Is Birthplace Of 1076 New Arrivals in 1949**

The wail of 1076 new born babies was heard at the Torrance Memorial Hospital during 1949.

All present directors of the Torrance Hospital Association last Friday, Miss Elsa Hammerstrom, superintendent, reported that the local hospital was the birthplace of 131 more babies in 1949 than a year ago.

Among the new arrivals were 20 who had company when they arrived—all being twins. Only one set of triplets has been born at the local hospital.

In making her annual report, Miss Hammerstrom stated that the hospital had established an enviable record.

Of the 1077 mothers who delivered there was not a single maternal death.

Speaking well for the hospital also were comparative figures on premature deaths. Although the hospital handled 1193 obstetrical cases in 1949, an increase of 88 over a year ago, the number of premature deaths in 1949 was only nine, compared to 19 in 1948.

The hospital handled an average of 12 babies and 35 adults per day.

The membership learned the non-profit community hospital handled 12,569 patient days during the year and rendered 4,721 baby days of service.

Construction of the hospital in 1925 was financed principally by heirs of the late Jared Sidney Torrance as a memorial to the city's founder. Subsequent gifts to the hospital have been made by local organizations and appreciative patients.

All present directors of the hospital association are remaining in office, and likewise the officers of the governing body remain unchanged. They are: R. R. Smith, president; Grover C. Whyte, vice president; Donald Findley, secretary; Dr. John W. Beaman, treasurer and Mrs. N. F. Jamieson, Mrs. C. A. Curtis, Mrs. L. C. Miller, Dr. Roy E. Fleisher and O. A. Kresse, directors.
