Labeling the proposed state constitutional amendment to abolish personal property tax as "discriminatory against homeowners," the Torrance City Council Tuesday night took action asking the voters to refuse to sign petitions in favor of the measure.

City Attorney C. Douglas Smith said the voters were being misinformed when told the measure would reduce taxes. He said the burden of maintaining police and fire protection, water service, sewage and other local services would be shifted onto the shoulders of homeowners and other property owners.

Much of the money collected from personal property taxes is used to defray the cost of running local governments, it was stated. If this tax is abolished it will mean that renters and other non-property owners will receive all the benefits of city, county, and state services—all of which will be paid for by homeowners and property owners, it was pointed out.

Recreation Board Asks City To Carry All of Financial Load

Though they allotted \$5000 for recreational purposes, the Board of Education last Tuesday night expressed the desire to be rid of any financial responsibilities for recreation in the future.

The board cut a request of F. H. Carpenter, recently appointed superintendent of recreation for the City of Torrance, from \$1000. The sum was half of the salary budget for recreation personnel for the period of July 1, 1950 to June 30, 1951.

The board in ordering a letter sent to the City Council said they felt they had a moral obligation to participate in a city school sponsored program this year but stated that in the future they felt the city should make budgetary allowance to carry the program alone.

Dr. Howard A. Wood, president of the Board, stated that the school trustees felt that the money voted by the people for education should be spent for education.

They also asked that the City Council following the recommendation of Ferdinand A. Baby, state recreation specialist, who urged the city to form a five man recreation commission composed of two men appointed by the city, two by the Board of Education, and one appointed by the aforementioned bureau.

Dr. J. Francis Hill, superintendent of schools, stated: "If the Board is to spend \$8500 for recreation I think they should have some control as how it is to be spent."

Buses To Take New Route In Kettler Knolls Rerouting of buses through the Kettler Knolls area, giving increased service to the new-home tract, was announced Tuesday by Marshall Chamberlain, manager of the Torrance Municipal Bus Lines.

Beginning Monday inbound buses will turn east on 235th street from Marianne avenue to Falcon avenue, thence to 234th street to Huber avenue, thence to Cabrillo avenue and then into bus terminal. Outbound buses will take the reverse route.

The first inbound bus will start the loop at 6:30 a.m. Chamberlain said. The first inbound out-bound bus will leave the depot at 6:45 a.m. The buses will continue to run on an hour-and-a-half minute schedule. The 10 cent fare will remain unchanged.
