Water System Overhaul May Bring Bond Vote

Torrance voters may face a bond issue approximating \$2 million by next fall, it was learned this week.

Meetings between the city water board, water department officials, and James G. Mont-gomery, hydro-engineer who recently completed a survey of the Torrance water system have resulted in a tentative decision to conduct such an election as soon as possible, city hall sources said.

It was estimated that it would require a year after the election to complete mest of the improvements, in the water system cited as necessary by Montgomery in his support.

These improvements would cost an estimated \$1.44,900, but this figure does not include purchase of several private water concerns, which Montgomery deems advisable.
