Unrecorded Contracts May Cost Veterans Exemptions

Veterans who are buying their homes and farms on un-recorded contracts, with the title vested in someone else's name, were warned this week by Miss Helen K. Dill, counselor at Veterans Service Center that they may lose out on their \$1000 property tax exemption if they do not take action to comply with a new state law.

The new law requires that the veteran's interest in his property must be on record in the office of his County Recorder on the first Monday in March before he can qualify for the \$1,000 exemption on the assessed valuation, for which he applies during the spring of each year.

Veterans must pay the fee for recording the contract. This generally runs from \$4 to \$6, depending on the length of the legal description of the property.

Veterans who are in doubt about their property pur-chase contracts should consult with Miss Dill at her office located at 1339 Post avenue. Torrance or go to the nearest Assessor's office.
