

## Role of Adult Education To Be Told by Director

The "Role of Adult Education" will be discussed by Donald Manashaw, Director of Torrance School of Adult Education at a free public forum on Monday night, November 20 at 8 p.m. in the Torrance High School auditorium.

The third in the series of "Magic Mondays in November," the Adult Education session will be devoted to the interchanging of ideas of the audience and the speaker. The talk will be on the human-interest side; and will tell the case histories of 12 Adult Education students—how Adult Education has changed their lives, their viewpoints, and their hopes for the future.

Manashaw will speak about an 82-year old student, a housewife who wants to start a new life, a young man who is trying to find a trade and a way to earn a respectable living, a woman who found a hobby and freedom from frustration and neuroses.

The Barbershop Chorus, under the direction of Charles Bartholomew, will open Manashaw's program. The Chorus will sing "The Old Songs, My Evaline, Honey, Coney Island, Girl of My Dreams, Sweet Adeline (Quartet), Sweet, Sweet Roses of Morn and Shine.

For the concluding lecture in "Magic Mondays in November" series "Helping Boys and Girls Grow Up" will be handled by Ralph Eckert, Chief of Parent Education, California State Department of Education.

These free public forums of special interest are open to all adults, regardless of residence. They are sponsored by the Torrance Unified School District, in cooperation with the L. A. County Teachers' Institute. Teachers who attend these forums will receive institute credit.
