To Be Described By Zamperini

Louis Zamperini, former Torrance athlete who has recently, returned from Japan, will be the principal speaker at Youth For Christ, Saturday, December 13, 7:30 pm., in the First Baptist Church, Carson and Mantuel avenue.

Under the suspices of Youth For Christ, he returned to Japan, three months ago, where he spoke in churches, universities, and youth rallies, During his stay, he contacted some of the prison guards that had administered punishment to him, during world war II. On personal 'invitation' of General Douglas MacArthur, Zamperini was able to see first hand the work of Communism, which he will relate in his address. He also visited Hroshima on which the first atomic bemb was dropped.

Meetings are open to the public and admission is free.

Zamperini, who was a member of the U. S. Olympic Team in 1936, also gained fame as a war here, having been shot down and imprisoned by the Japanese for three yearts. He was "converted" a year ago, under the
