Reminds Vets That GI Bill Deadline Near

Veterans who have not begun their educational training under the GI bill must enroll for the spring semester if they wish to start their program during a regular school year, according to announcement of H. H. Sheffield, El Camino College director of student personnel.

Final date for veterans to begin college training under the bill is July 25.

El Camino College's spring semester begins February 1, with registration scheduled January 29, 30, and 31. Veterans intending to take advantage of the educational bill are urged to apply immediately to the Veterans Administration for their letters of entitlement.
