Four cases of polio were re-ported in Torvance last year according to a review of polio-myelltis in Los Angeles County which was compiled and re-leased this week by Dr. Roy Gilbert, county health afficer. The case rate for the city, based on 100,000 population, was 179

There were no deaths reported

There were no deaths reported in 1950.

For the entire Los Angeles County area preliminary figures show 986 polio cases, a reduction of 240 cases below the total for the previous year, and 24 deaths—14 lower than the number occurring in 1949.

The last epidemic year was in 1948, when there were 3129 cases of polio with 137 deaths.

Approximately 71 per cent of the total number of cases occurred during the period from July, through November in 1950.
