

Municipal Band Offers Free Concert Tonight

Lucien Cailliet, nationally known conductor, arranger and composer will be guest conductor tonight at the Torrance Civic Auditorium when the Torrance Municipal Band presents its annual spring concert. Cailliet will lead the band in three of his own arrangements during the latter half of the program. The first part of the concert will be directed by James Van Dyck, the band's regular conductor, and by Clem Hutchinson, instructor in woodwinds at the University of Southern California.

Cailliet will conduct his own arrangement of "A Mighty Fortress is Our God", waltzes from "Der Rosenkavalier" from the opera by Richard Strauss, and "Homage to the U. S. Navy", a number especially written for the official United States Band during the last war. Other numbers on the program include "Emblem of Unity", a march; "Capriccio Italian", by Tschai-kowsky; "The Three Trumpeters", trumpet trio played by Jonathan Murakami, Marino Menni, and Don Rader; "Wag-gery for Woodwinds", "Folk Song Suite", by Vaughan Wil-liams; and "Caribbean Fantasy".

Cailliet was for 15 years chief arranger for Leopold Stokow-sky and the Philadelphia Sym-phony Orchestra. He came to the west coast in 1940 and spent the following seven years teaching at the University of Southern California and writing music for motion pictures. In 1949 and '50 he toured the United States as arranger and conductor of the Ballet Russe de Monte Carlo. At the present time he is writ-ing original scores for motion pictures and writing band and orchestra music for publication.

Tonight's concert will begin at 8:15. It is open to the public without charge. Preceding the concert, members of the Torrance Area Youth Band, their parents and friends will have a covered dish supper.
