General Petroleum Seeks OK for New Savings Plan

General Petroleum Corporation announced this week that the Socony-Vacuum Oil Company, Inc., is filing a registration statement with the Securities and Exchange Commission relating to an Employee Savings Plan which is now being considered by certain government agencies.

As Western affiliate of Socony-Vacuum, General Petroleum employees will be eligible to participate.

Under the plan an employee could allot up to five per cent of his base pay for the plan and the company would contribute an additional half of whatever the employee allots, subject to certain limitations.

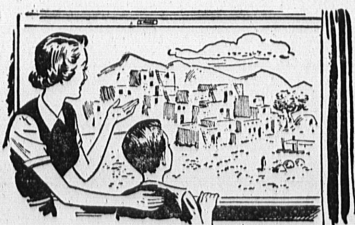
