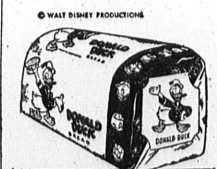
Much confusion has been reigning lately as to the hours of the Walteria branch library.

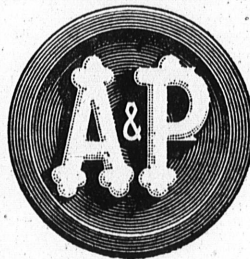
