

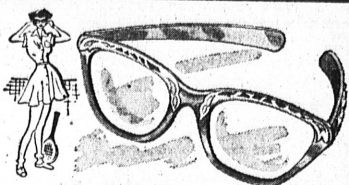
## Tax Delinquent Record Sets New Low Mark

Supervisor Darby reports that during the last fiscal year ending June 30, only 1.4% of the taxes due Los Angeles County remain unpaid, this being the lowest record in the history of the County. It means that of the total tax bill owing to the County 98.597% had been paid, indicating the prosperity generally prevailing and the desire of people to prevent their property from becoming tax delinquent.

## Postal Receipts Show Huge Gain

Torrance postal receipts for July 1951 were \$17,122.97, according to Mrs. Clara Conner, Torrance Postmaster. This compares to \$11,635.46 for the same month last year. The difference of \$5,487.51 represents an increase of 47 per cent, she said.

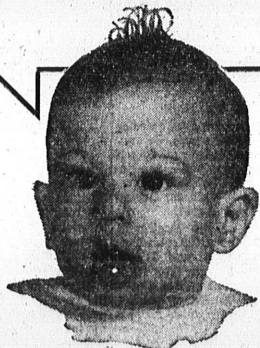

## Longren Workers Enjoy Mid-Summer Christmas

Employees at Longren Aircraft celebrated Christmas last week. To the workers it was nothing too unusual. They celebrate Christmas four times a year.

While a loud speaker system piped Christmas carols throughout the plant and a traditionally decorated lighted tree occupied a conspicuous spot in the aircraft parts manufacturing plant, the employees were wishing each other a Merry Christmas.

Presentations were passed out on behalf of the company by Hampton Wentworth, the flying vice-president of the company. Occasion for all the celebrating was that last Friday was "D-Day"—dividend day at the Carson street plant.

Four times each year the company declares a 24 per cent profit-sharing dividend for the employees. After each business quarter the company adds up the profit, prorates the money among the company's workers. Checks to the employees have been as high as \$300 for a three-month period.

"Celebrating Christmas this way is better than on December 25," one employee said. "There are no bills to pay afterward."

## WAC, WAF Corps Reduces 3 Year Enlistment Term

Qualified young women may now enlist in the Women's Army Corps for a minimum of two years, Cpl. John U. Tachihara, Local Recruiter, announced this week.

Previously, the minimum period of enlistment in the WAC had been set at three years, the local recruiter explained.

Enlistment requirements for both WAC and WAF branches remain unchanged, Cpl. Tachihara said. Applicants must be 18 to 34 years of age, single, high school graduates, and meet physical and mental standards for enlistment.

Cpl. Tachihara also wants to remind the men of this area who have taken their pre-induction physical they may volunteer for the branch of service of their choice until August 31.

Men who have received their notice for induction do not qualify for this choice of service.
