Sailor Visits Parents Here After War Duty

A sailor who saw 27 of his buddies killed when his ship hit a mine in Korean waters is home this week visiting his parents and sisters.

Home is Junior D. McGuire, son of Mr. and Mrs. G. D. McGuire, of 20511 Victor street. On hand to greet him also were his two sisters, Mrs. John Rogers of Lomita, and Mrs. Helen Weeks of Torrance.

McGuire said his ship exploded a mine on June 15, 1951, and that 27 of the men aboard were killed and seven wounded. Before entering the service last November McGuire was employed at the Petroleum Maintenance Company.

Rover Picnic Set For Next Sunday


