For the Olympians it will be a matter of maintaining the stature gained last week when they whitewashed the Redondo team 13-0.

Torrance should win the game, but it won't be an easy one. The Leuzinger gang has some talented ball handlers and their T-formation plays will bear watching.

Olymps Break Jinx, Blank Redondo 13-0

The Leuzinger Olympians pulled the season's first major upset last Friday night when they blanked the Redondo Seahawks 13-0 before a sell-out crowd at the Redondo stadium.

Both teams showed no offensive power, but the difference in scoring was attributed to the strong Leuzinger line.

Both Leuzinger t.d.s came on Hawk fumbles. Just before the first half ended, Dick Lindner picked up a fumble in the Hawk backfield and scooted 43 yards to pay dirt.

In the third quarter, the Olympians recovered another Hawk fumble on the Hawks' three-yard stripe, but were held out in four tries at the goal. A short punt by Redondo kept the Olympians in the game however, and a 19-yard pass from Don Bevans to Hank Bojorquez turned the trick.

The win for the Olympians ended a jinx that had plagued them since they entered the Bay League. It was the first win they ever chalked up at the expense of the Hawks. It was also their first league win of the season, as they dropped their opener to Inglewood the week before.

The Olympians will be gunning for their second win here tomorrow night, as they visit the Tartars here.
