

Act to Acquire New Site for Narbonne High

Condemnation proceedings to acquire 25 acres of land for a new Narbonne High School site at Western avenue and Lomita boulevard, it was learned this week.

Announcement of the action was made by the Los Angeles City Board of Education, under whose jurisdiction the Lomita high school has been placed.

The Board has already acquired 12 acres of the proposed site, but are acting now for the balance of the acreage. Funds for the construction of the new school hinge on a proposed \$200,000,000 school bond issue.

The present facilities of Narbonne High School at 253rd street and Walnut would be renamed and used as a junior high school, officials say.


