God as Only Creator is C. S. Sermon

The practical significance of the fact that God is the only cause and creator will be considered in the Sunday Lesson-Sermon in all Christian Science churches. The Golden Text from Genesis declares, "In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth" (1:1).

Luke's Gospel records that Jesus "entered into the synagogue and taught; and there was a man whose right hand was withered. And the scribes and Pharisees watched him, whether he would heal on the Sabbath day; that they might find an accusation against him. But he knew their thoughts and said to the man which had the withered hand, Rise up, and stand forth in the midst. . . . And looking round about upon them all, he said unto the man, Stretch forth thy hand. And he did so; and his hand was restored whole as the other" (6:6, 7, 8, 10).

In "Science and Health" with Key to the Scriptures" Mary Baker Eddy says, "Our Master treated error through Mind. He never enjoined obedience to the laws of nature, if by these are meant laws of matter, nor did he use drugs. There is a law of God applicable to healing, and it is a spiritual law instead of material" (p. 463).

Universal Bible Sunday To Be Observed Here

Central Evangelical United Brethren Church will observe Universal Bible Sunday, December 9, Rev. H. 44. Miller announced, this week.

Rev. Miller will speak on "Why I Believe in the Bible" at the 11 a. m. worship service. He will deliver an all-scriptural sermon, "The Way of Life," at the evening service.

Awards will be presented to the persons bringing the oldest, largest, and smallest Bibles, and to the person bringing the Bible which has had the most interesting associations.

The Torrance First Baptist Church will observe World Baptist Women's day of prayer Friday with services in the church annex.

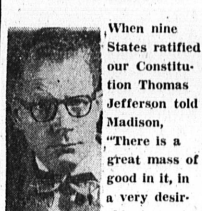
The service will begin at 10:30 a.m., and continue to 2:30 in the afternoon. Women are asked to bring their own lunch. Tea and coffee will be served at noon.

OUR BILL OF RIGHTS



When nine States ratified our Constitution Thomas Jefferson told Madison, "There is a great mass of good in it, in a very desirable form; but there is also a bitter pill or two." Then went on to explain, "A Bill of Rights is what the people are entitled to against every government on earth, general or particular (Federal or State), and what no just government should refuse, or rest on inference."

There was a time in our country when a person accused of being a "witch" was burned; when a flimsy accusation could mean incarceration; when we would have been circumspect in our public or private utterances; when news was colored by expediency; when long periods of time elapsed from arrest to trial; when search warrants were not necessary—our Bill of Rights remedied these conditions.

There is no other part of our Constitution that affects us so intimately as our Bill of Rights. We will celebrate the 160th anniversary of the ratification of these amendments from Dec. 9th to 15th. Know your Bill of Rights.
