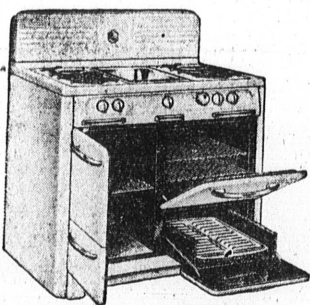

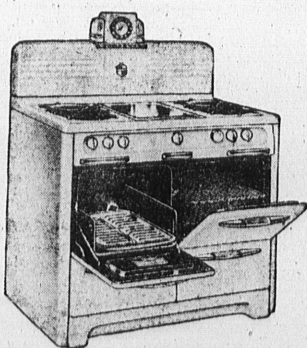

Adult School Offers Several Craft Classes

Several free arts and crafts classes are held weekday nights at the Torrance Evening High School, and are open to all adults regardless of residence. Newcomers may register at any time.

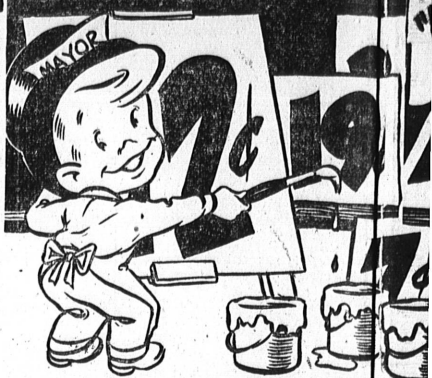
