## Korean Fight Talk Keeps Chief Busy

A former Pacific Electric storekeeper is supervising the communications system of a combat engineer battalion in Korea. He is Sergeant First Class Norman R. Stock, son of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Stock of 1412 Manuel Ave., "commo" chief for the 578th Engineer Combat Battalion, part of Southern California's 10th Infantry Division.

Stock was storekeeper at Pacific Electric's Dominguez St. facility in Torrance prior to being called to active duty with the 40th in September, 1950.

He was sent to Korea with the 40th in January after 16 months training with his unit in Camp Cooke, Calif. and in Japan.

"Most of us were glad to get to Korea," Stock declared. "It isn't too bad over here and now we feel like we're doing something—doing the job we were trained for."

Stock's unit, Headquarters and Service Company of the 578th, was stationed at Camp Mateu-shima, in the northern part of Japan's main island of Honshu, during its entire nine months in Japan.

"Our camp was quite comfortable and Japan was very interesting," explained Stock, "but the training was getting tiresome after 16 months."

His wife, Norma Ruth, and three-month-old son, Timothy Craig, live in Redondo Beach.

Stock's father is Pacific Electric's general storekeeper and company employee for 45 years.
