ship for Coolerator freezers and a wholesale food plan.

Busy with plans for tomorrow's Grand Opening in their new store are the three partners, Jim Lawson, Walt Schaefer and Milt Isbell.

"We are going to make some popovers for the kiddies in one of the freezers on display," Lawson said.

A factory representative for the Coolerators will be on hand to explain the technicalities of the freezer to the mechanically-minded and to explain the uses and advantages of the unit to the housewives, Schaefer said.

The trio will have gifts for ladies visiting the store during their opening celebration tomorrow.

"Buying such a piece of equipment is like buying a car or a house," Schaefer said. "Both the husband and the wife want to look it all over before buying."

To enable families to get into the store together, the company will keep its doors open seven days a week, Isbell said. Hours Monday through Saturday will be 9 a.m. until 9:30 p.m. The store will be open from 12 noon until 9 p.m. on Sundays.

The company will have models of the various freezers available on display at all times in its new home, and orders for food can be placed through the office, although no food displays will be set up, one of the partners said.

### 'Ab' Season Opens Sunday

Skin divers—abalone fishermen—can break out their trunks because abalone season opens Sunday for ten-long months, the Department of Fish and Game says.

But, fishermen must now be equipped with an accurate measuring device, a new 1952 regulation.

Last year's bag limit of five per day and size limits of seven inches for reds, six and one-quarter for greens, six for pinks and five inches for blacks will be in effect this year.

All ab's must be brought ashore above the high water mark; they must be alive and attached to the shell. Spears and artificial breathing devices are prohibited, the department states.

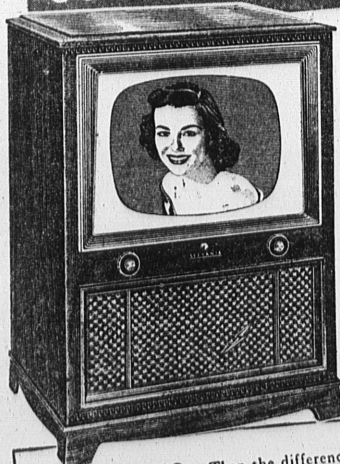

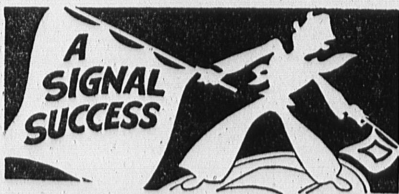
