Tony Pereira, president of the City Recreation and Park Commission; and spokesmen for various Harbor District civic, business, fraternal youth and other groups.

Activity Review
Following the dedication program, a review of the new play center's recreation features, "Normandale Playground Activity Parade," was presented by groups of children from several Harbor District municipal playgrounds under the direction of Ms. Iltzmillier and Valerio.

Activities depicted included an archery exhibition by children from Banning Playground; square dancing by teenage boys and girls from Banning Playground; a vocal duet by Jane and Sue Gately, Normandale Playground; a puppet show, youngsters from Normandale Playground; and a dance, "Taran-tel," Lamp Club girls' Normandale Playground.

The program ended with a display of arts and crafts in the game room of the clubhouse and escorted tours of the playground and its clubhouse with "highlights" from the Normandale Playground Associated Boys' Club acting as guides.

Bond Financed
Normandale Playground's outdoor facilities and its clubhouse were financed under provisions

of the city's 1947 bond issue for additional recreation centers.

The playground's outdoor development includes a play area for small children, an apparatus pit, fields for baseball, softball, and touch football; an outdoor gymnasium for basketball, volleyball, and similar games; and a picnic area.

Overall dimensions of the community clubhouse are 30 by 109 feet. Facilities include a 28 by 49-foot auditorium; an office for the center's recreation directors, boys' and girls' dressing rooms and showers, a kitchen, a room for meetings of craft classes and community groups, and storage facilities.
