

Your Community Chest Dollars at Work in Torrance

Last year 5422 Torrance area residents received service from one or more of the 160 agencies supported by your Community Chest. This year those same agencies desperately need funds to keep their doors open for the coming year.

Here in Torrance a goal of \$12,864 has been set as the local share of the \$8 million that must be raised in the Los Angeles Chest Area.

Here in Torrance, the Chest provides funds for the operation of eight agencies—the Torrance YWCA, Camp Fire Girls, Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, Veterans Service Center, Pueblo CYO Center, Catholic Welfare Bureau and Family Service, in addition to the Community Chest-Service-Center at 1103 Sartori.

In addition to these local agencies, Chest funds provide hospital and clinic care at hospitals such as Children's Hospital, Orthopaedic Hospital, and California Babies Clinic, which serve the entire Los Angeles area.
