

Torrance Sixth Again in County Building Ranks

Torrance ranks sixth among Los Angeles county cities in total valuation of building permits issued during the month of November, the Los Angeles Chamber of Commerce Construction Industries Department revealed this week.

Total valuation of the 226 permits issued here is \$1,028,616, an increase of over half a million dollars from last November's figure, \$460,815.

The construction here compares with the five other leading cities as follows:

Comparison figures exclude Los Angeles proper, which came out with a total construction valuation of \$24,705,992 and total building permits numbering 4520.

All but \$112,516 of the total Torrance building valuation will be used to construct new homes, 112 dwelling units valued at \$916,100.

This continues a county trend, for throughout the Los Angeles area, home building has accounted for the major portion of this year's construction.

Of the total \$856,842,495 building permits issued during the first eleven months of this year, \$590,356,631, or 69 per cent of the aggregate, was earmarked for homes.

These permits will build enough dwelling units to house 220,856 persons in this area, according to Chairman Milton J. Brock of the construction industries committee.

Hearing Set On Sewers For 223rd St.

A public hearing has been scheduled for 10 a.m. Jan. 13, on the intention of the Board of Supervisors to construct sanitary sewers in 223rd St., Supervisor Raymond V. Darby announced yesterday.

The project, which embraces a section of 223rd between Normandie Ave. and Meyley St., was adopted as a necessary health measure because of the many complaints received on the present sewage disposal systems, Darby said.

Body of Drowned HC Boy is Found

The 14-year-old Harbor City youth was drowned Sunday when a wave swept him to his death as he was fishing from a rock at Point Fermin.

A companion, Jack Boyce, 14, 2352 Marigold Ave., Wilmington, escaped the same wave by clinging to a rock. Young McClelland lived at 909 W. 256th St.
