# Jaycee Speaker Demonstrates Microwave Relay

A discussion and demonstration of microwave radio relay—the system employed to bring live television shows here from the east—was given here Thursday evening at a dinner program of the Torrance Junior Chamber of Commerce.

C. Corbin Devalon, a representative of the Pacific Telephone, and Telegraph Co., set up a miniature microwave relay station in the American Legion hall and graphically demonstrated the properties of the microwaves which are used to transmit six television shows or 3600 telephone conversations over one relay system.

Devalon was introduced by program chairman Bert Lamb. The speaker demonstrated how like light waves, the microwave beams could be reflected but at the super high frequencies are not troubled by aran, made interferences.
