 The following requirements have been set up for donors:
 1 Must be between the ages of 21 and 60. Persons from 18 to 21 may donate blood with the written permission of parent or legal guardian. (Release slip available at office). Married female minors may sign their own release, married male minors must have written permission of wife.
 2. Donors must weigh at least 110 pounds.
 3. Persons may not donate at intervals less than 12 weeks.
 4. Persons planning to donate should eat a regular meal, avoiding fatty foods.
 5. Members of Air Force or plane crews of commercial airlines cannot donate if they participate in flight operations within a period of 72 hours.
 For the donor's protection, adequate examination including temperature, pulse, blood pressure, and hemoglobin determination is given prior to a blood donation.

Participating in training exercises aboard the destroyer USS John W. Thomason is Edwin L. Cortelyou, fireman, USN, son of Mr. and Mrs. Dale E. Cortelyou of 18321 Regina Ave., and husband of Mrs. Mary Cortelyou, of 331 Harbor Hills, Lomita.

The vessel is a unit of the 26-ship task force, composed of cruisers, destroyers, destroyer escorts, submarines and service support ships. They are shooting at surface and air targets; repelling simulated enemy submarine and air attacks; exercising at replenishing and refueling under way; and executing intricate battle maneuvers.

The ships left from west coast ports yesterday. The two-week operation will be broken by a visit to San Francisco, Calif., Jan. 10 and 11. Rear Admiral Herbert G. Hopwood, USN, is in command of the exercise.

A total of 96 pints of blood was donated to the San Pedro Naval Supply Depot's blood bank, which was held this week. A mobile unit of the American Red Cross visits the depot each quarter to collect vitally needed blood for wounded fighting men in Korea.
