

County Counsel Seeks to Settle City-County Row

Tentative draft of the complete new bill which may settle the long existing dispute between the League of California Cities and the heavily populated, unincorporated communities was completed Saturday by County Counsel Harold W. Kennedy. He said it will be introduced immediately into the Legislature by Assemblyman Earl Stanley of Balboa Beach.

The bill would amend the government code to provide for creation of what will be officially known as "County Service Areas" which will furnish extra police, fire, park and other public services to areas not having a city government. A special tax must be levied to finance the County Service Areas.

Proceedings to create such areas can be initiated at any time, but must be completed after July 1 and not later than Dec. 31 of each year.

Such proceedings may be instituted by the Board of Supervisors on its own initiative. The second method of starting service areas would be by petition of residents of the area, signed by not less than 10 per cent of the registered voters.

It is further provided that voters can bring referendum proceedings against formation of such service areas, by proper petition of 10 per cent of the voters. No service area can be formed without a majority vote of the residents involved.

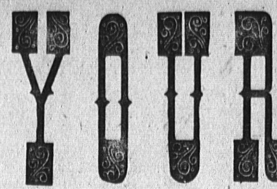

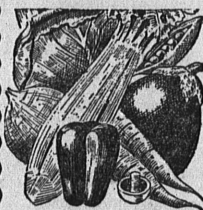
