

# Pedestrian Killed In Highway Crash

Redondo Beach Blvd. was the site of two weekend traffic accidents, including one in which a pedestrian was killed. Demetrio V. Morales, 48, 700 W. E St., Wilmington, died Sunday from a basal skull fracture when he was struck by a sedan driven by Carl M. Martin, 38, 937 11th St., Manhattan Beach.

He was pronounced dead about seven feet off the road arrival at the Park Emergency Hospital.

Martin told investigating traffic officers that he had been driving east on Redondo Beach Blvd. just east of Prairie Ave. at approximately 40 miles an hour.

Suddenly, he said, he thought he hit a pedestrian. He checked the vicinity but was unable to find a victim. He summoned Redondo Beach police. A search of the area turned up the body of Morales, which had been lying

and had lost control on a curve. The Fgildo car hit the corner of a malt shop building owned by Darrel H. Sanders, 4567 Redondo Beach Blvd., bounded off and hit Sanders' parked car and then careened out into a fire and hit a car owned by Charles F. Nesbitt, 4569 Redondo Beach Blvd.
