

Publisher Tells Of Progress by Suburban Press

Progress made during the past year by the community and suburban press of Los Angeles County in distributing official information for the public was outlined in the Nineteenth Annual report of the president of the Los Angeles Newspaper Service Bureau, Inc., at the Annual Stockholders' Meeting held last week.

President H. A. Lawson, publisher of the Eagle Rock Sentinel, told the group, which is representative of the Torrance Herald and 106 other weekly and daily newspapers, that new legislation has been introduced at Sacramento to provide that the lists of election officers and polling precinct places be published in community newspapers throughout the county so that the voters may see the lists.

At present such notices, although published as required by law, are printed in a single newspaper of negligible circulation.

Similar legislation is being asked to scatter the lists of tax delinquencies, which also under present statutes are printed in a single small newspaper, he reported.

The president reported that the Newspaper Cooperative and its various affiliated enterprises are now employing seventy people. It has just completed its 19th year of service to the taxpayers and citizens of Los Angeles County, he said.
