Seven Stunt Teams to Risk Death at Carrell Sunday

Hailed as the most colorful auto thrill show in the world, the International Stuntmen Assn. will open its 1953 season Sunday at Carrell Speedway.

Seven teams of auto daredevils will battle in the first clash of the season in a series of twelve spectacular stunts using brand new 1953 Fords.

Such spine-tingling feats as crashing two speeding cars head on, crashing through flaming plank walls with motorcycles, the sensational stunt of broad-jumping a brand new car over a row of cars, and dive bombing an automobile off an improvised precipice into rows of parked cars are on the program.

These and many other amazing stunts will be performed by the seven teams of stuntmen, gathered from all over the world.

There'll be Sakl Kimura, the Japanese sensation from Tokyo and Salt Lake City; Bill Ward and his Canadian Aces; Dutch Schnitzer, his German Circus of Death; Angel Lopez y sus Diablos del Tlmon of Mexico City; Cliff Mehjors and the Jole Chitwood Daredevils; Harry Woolwood's Hollywood Stuntmen; Jimmy Williams and the Lone Star Daredevils from Dallas, Tex.; and Von Hunter and the Indianapolis Daredevils. Hunter has replaced Bill Holland, Indianapolis race champion, as head of the team, while Bill is again trying his luck at racing with 3-A.

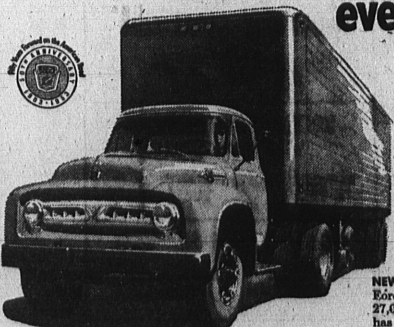
