

Dial Telephones On the Way; Job Half Done

Dial operation of Torrance tele-
phones is a step nearer this
week with more than 55 per
cent of the instruments already
modified or replaced. District
Manager Frank G. Jordan of
Pacific Telephone announced to
day.

As installers proceed with the
job of adding dials to subscrib-
ers' telephones, outside construc-
tion forces are moving ahead
with the rearrangement of cab-
les and wire facilities.

Meanwhile, Western Electric in-
stallers are continuing to make
speedy progress with the im-
portant job of installing the
huge dial system known as
"crossbar" in the central office
building at 1307 Cravens Ave.
The system will bring dial com-
munications here on May 31.

Supervising Plant Service Fore-
man R. G. Garner said the in-
stallers started equipping tele-
phones for dial operation last
January and the project will be
completed before the cut-over
date.

"Dials should not be used at
this time, however," he pointed
out. "All calls should be given
to the operator in the usual
manner. Turning the dials now
may result in an interruption to
service."

Will Issue Bike Licenses Here

Los Angeles city bicycle li-
censes will be issued at the
Normandale playground on Sat-
urday, Apr. 11, from 9 a. m. un-
til 2 p. m., according to Harold
Unander, chairman of Council-
man John Gibson's advisory
committee.

Bicycle owners will receive an
identification card along with
the license and a duplicate card
will be sent to the Los Angeles
police for filing. The registra-
tion fee is 50 cents and the li-
cense is good until January of
1954.

Ordinarily, the licensing ser-
vice is rendered only at a Los
Angeles or at the San Pedro
police station, however, through
the cooperation of the Harbor
Division Police Department, two
police officers will be sent to
the playground to register the
bicycles.
